### **Competition**

Kent & Masters Arena Eventing is a two phase competition, run at BE90 and BE100 level where riders can win the opportunity to compete at one of the two Kent & Masters Arena Eventing Championships to be held at

Blair Castle International 25th to 28th August 2016 and  
Blenheim Palace International 8th to 11th September 2016.

Competitors will jump a course of show jumps immediately followed by cross country fences, based on an optimum time of 375m/min for the XC phase. The optimum time will be as agreed with the course designer depending upon the size and terrain of the arena.

The clear round closest to this time will be the winner.

The BE Arena Eventing season will run 1st January to 30th June 2016.

The information you have provided in connection with your entry to the British Eventing Arena Eventing competition will be disclosed to British Eventing Ltd and their employees and the Organising teams of the British Eventing Arena Eventing Championships. Your data will also be disclosed to a number of third party organisations in order to provide an Online Entries system for the Finals. Your competition records will be displayed on the league table and on the British Eventing website for the final and may be displayed on the event organiser's website, and any site owned by the provider of an Online Entries systems. Should you receive an injury as the direct result of an accident occurring whilst you are participating in any event organised by an affiliated event organiser, any medical reports relating to your condition will be passed to British Eventing.

Any Medical Reports passed to British Eventing will be held on your records and passed in confidence to the

## **Terms and Conditions**

- 1 The competition will be run in accordance with British Eventing rules.
- 2 Correct standard headgear and riding dress should be worn in all classes. Anyone not complying may be asked to leave the competition and forfeit their entry fee.
- 3 Dress code is Cross Country attire. Body protectors must be worn for both phases
- 4 The Decision of the Judges is Final. Competitors who disobey any Judge or Officials decision could be refused entry into any future Bovington Equestrian competitions. All our Judges and Officials are volunteers.
- 5 The RAC Saddle Club reserve the right to refuse or cancel any entry or entries of any person if they shall deem it fit to do so without reason for doing so.
- 6 Entries must be made on the accompanying form and accompanied by a cheque for the relevant amount.
- 7 The Organisers reserve the right to refuse entry, cancel, change or close classes at their discretion.
- 8 Neither the organisers, landowners, or the committee accept liability for accidents, loss, damage, or illness of any horse, owner, rider, spectator, pet or any other person or property whatsoever.
- 9 No entry fee will be refunded after the closing date without a Vet's certificate.
- 10 In the event of adverse weather conditions, it is the competitors responsibility to contact the organisers to seek confirmation of the cancellation of any event.
- 11 Dogs must be kept on leads and children must be kept under control at all times.
- 12 Please remove all your horses droppings from the lorry park.

## **BE Masters and Kent Arena Eventer Qualifying Classes**

- They will run at BE 90 & BE 100 Level.
- The classes are unrestricted and are open to everyone, members of BE and non-members alike.
- Riders of all ages and horses of any height may compete in the qualifiers, however to compete at the Championships both horses and competitors must meet the minimum eligibility requirements for BE membership and horse registration: Competitors must be at least in the year of their 12th birthday and horses must be at least 142cms in height.
- Each venue will run their own event under their own rules and any queries regarding results will be dealt with by the venue directly. BE accepts no responsibility for loss or liability with regards to the running of these events.
