**ALL CLASSES ARE CRICKLANDS QUALIFIERS**

1. The competition will be run in accordance with the rules and regulations as laid down by BS. It is the responsibility of competitors to know the rules.
2. Correct headgear and riding dress up to BS standard should be worn in all classes. A body protector is advised for riders under 18. Anyone not complying may be asked to leave the competition and forfeit their entry fee.
3. Neither the organisers, landowners, or the committee accept liability for accidents, loss, damage, or illness of any horse, owner, rider, spectator, pet or personal property.
4. The Committee reserve the right to cancel or divide any class, to alter advertised times and to refuse any entry, if they shall deem it fit, without reason for doing so.
5. The Decision of the Judges is Final. Competitors who disobey any Judge or Officials decision could be refused entry into any future RAC Saddle Club competitions. Please remember that all our officials on the day are volunteers
6. The judge may disqualify any competitor for misuse of whips or spurs.
7. All dogs must be on leads at all times, and all children must be kept under control.
8. Horses may be ridden twice in the same class by the same or different riders with permission of the judge. The second rider must ride HC.
9. In the event of adverse weather conditions, it is the competitors responsibility to telephone the venue to confirm the competition is still running.
10. Under no circumstances will entry fees be refunded due to cancellation by competitors, unless accompanied by a Veterinary Certificate.
12. No horse or pony under 4 years may enter.
13. No unauthorised persons are to enter the arenas unless invited to do so.
14. Only Bovington livery horses are allowed on the yard, all other horses must remain either on the lorry park or in the arena area.
15. Please remove all your horse droppings from the lorry park and take your rubbish home
16. When you walk the course you should also walk the jump off course.
17. All lone riders must notify the office with the details of NOK.
