

Rules: -

1. Hard hats, to be worn as per Riding Club 2018 rules.
2. Horses to be at least 4 years old.
3. Judges' decision is final.
4. Objections must be handed to the Secretary within 15 mins of the class ending together with a deposit of £5
5. No entry fee will be refunded without a doctor or vet's certificate.
6. All dogs must always be kept on leads & under control.
7. In the event of cancellation, the Organisers reserve the right to retain £5 of the entry fee to cover administration costs.
8. Please ensure that you pick up all litter and droppings.

HEALTH and SAFETY POLICY FOR B&DRC:

1: The organiser has overall responsibility for Health and Safety.

2: The event is organised in accordance with Health and Safety Legislation and all who have, to any extent, control of the premises, or site on which the event are responsible for ensuring that: • Everything reasonably practicable is done to ensure health, safety and welfare of those attending the event • They conduct themselves so that they do not put themselves or anyone else at risk • The access to and egress from the site is safe and unobstructed.

3: Emergencies

- Emergency services must always have access to all parts of the event site and members of the public must not park vehicles to obstruct access.
- First aid points are clearly marked.
- In the case of an emergency, members of the public should contact the nearest official or dial 999 on the nearest accessible telephone (landline or mobile)

4: Horses can easily be frightened and can be dangerous. Members of the public are requested to keep clear from horse areas/lanes and to avoid behaviour that might alarm horses.

5: Dogs should be kept under close control and on a short lead. The dangerous dogs act now covers private land (Nov 2014).
