

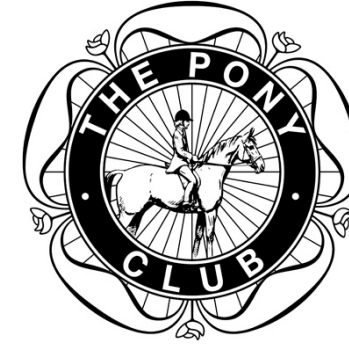
## Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times

- This event is run under Pony Club Eventing Rules 2016
- Back protectors and medical arm bands are mandatory on the cross-country course
- No horse may compete in a class more than twice
- Hats must comply with current Pony Club regulations
- Pony Club members must have white hat tag (tags available at the Secretary's tent)
- Competitors are asked to wear correct dress
- No horse or pony under 4 years old may enter any class
- A whistle or flag will be used to stop any competitor on the course in the event of an accident or fence being knocked down. Please be alert!
- Dressing fences to be jumped by both horses/ponies together, side by side in the Pairs class.
- The judge's decision is final.
- Objections must be made within 15 minutes of the alleged offence and must be accompanied by a fee of £10 which will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
- Entry fees are not refundable except on production of a vet or doctor's certificate. All fees are non-transferable.
- The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry.
- All owners and competitors must ensure that they and their horse are fit and at an appropriate standard to compete. Anyone deemed unfit or endangering others may be asked to leave.
- Anyone abusing/galloping their horse/pony will be asked to leave.
- No illegal assistance by spectators.
- No recording devices on hats are permitted.
- Competitors may be disqualified for misuse of whips or spurs.
- The organisers reserve the right to cancel any classes with insufficient entries.
- In the case of adverse weather conditions it is the competitor's responsibility to seek confirmation as to the cancellation of the event

### LEGAL LIABILITY

1. Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other personal property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.
2. The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present at this event. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents. They must obey the instructions of the organisers and all officials and stewards.
3. All non Pony Club competitors are not covered by The Pony Club insurance and must have their own third party cover. The Cattistock Hunt Branch of The Pony Club and the organisers of this event are not legally responsible for non Members and their insurance will not cover you.

# CLASSES

## **Class 1. BEGINNERS NOVICE - Fences up to 70cm**

This class will be split if sufficient entries: **9am PROMPT START**

Section A: For horse/pony and rider combinations not placed 1st to 6th in any Hunter Trial ODE at this height or higher. Riders may be led.

Section B: Open to any horse/pony and rider

## **Class 2. NOVICE - Fences up to 80cm**

For Horse/pony and rider combinations that have not won more than £30 prize money in any Hunter Trial/ODE

## **Class 3. PAIRS - Fences up to 80cm**

Open to any pair of horses or ponies. The course will include dressing fences.

## **Class 4. OPEN - Fences up to 90cm**

Open to any horse/pony and rider.

## **Class 5. TEAM PURSUIT - Fences up to 80cm**

Teams of 3. All three competitors must finish. Open to any horse/pony and riders.

## **MINIMUS CLEAR ROUND - Fences up to 60cm**

To encourage the youngest riders. Ponies may be led.

Entries on the day. £5 a round.
