## RULES

1. All ponies competing in the mountain & moorland classes must be registered or registration applied for, with appropriate breed Society to compete in the pure bred classes
2. The organizers accept no responsibility for loss or damage to any items or vehicles or persons competing, attending, assisting or watching the event
3. The judges decision is final
4. In event of a complaint this must be handed in writing to the secretary within 20 minutes of the finish of the class with £40 IN CASH, the money will be forfeited if the objections is upheld
5. All Stallions must be shown and bitted as per breed society rules, no handler's under 14 years for stallions/colts.
6. It is a condition of entry that all exhibitors have current third party liability insurance.
7. Any persons who is deemed to be mistreating ponies or abusive behavior/social media harassment towards any other competitors /judges/stewards or organizers will be asked to remove themselves/ponies from the showground and all entry fees will be forfeited
8. Correctly fitted NPS Standard British Standard 3 point-fixing hats must be worn at all times when mounted.
9. Snaffle bits only as per shown in the schedule are acceptable to be worn at the event. All novice ponies to be shown in snaffles. No Wilkie bits to be used as a double bit.
10. The committee reserve the right to combine/split classes according to entries

11. No spurs to be worn at any time on the show ground or in the ring, ponies being exercised before entry into the ring must only wear tack that is acceptable in the show ring. No Side reins allowed when warming up. Please take care when lunging to ensure you have enough room to do this safely.
12. Dogs: are allowed on the showground, please keep them on a lead at all times, and clear up after them.
13. No mucking out of horseboxes in the car parking areas please, and take your rubbish home with you.
14. Part Bred M&M ponies must be registered with the respective Mountain & Moorland Breed Society

## **TSR TRAINING CLASS** **& TSR/HOYS MASTER CLASS** **TALENT SPOTTING**

The class is open to everyone and the judge/trainer will give feed back to the exhibitor during the class. The class WILL NOT be placed but everyone will get a rosette.

Each class will be run on the following format: Enter the ring and go round as a class, line up in any order. The judge will watch and give feed back on individual shows and will then cover presentation, in hand technique etc.

### Talent Spotting - Who are we Spotting?

TSR is looking for talented riders and their horses/ponies who have potential as a combination. We are looking for riders who have a good understanding of the importance of basic flatwork training techniques demonstrating this through the development of their horses/pony's training and paces. Riders must be 8 years & over and riding off the lead rein to be talent spotted (there is no upper age limit)

If you are spotted you will be notified by the judge

Riders in the Pre Hoys Group can notify TSR by email they have been spotted and will be included on the Pathway as Talented riders to watch for the future. They can update TSR with their progress and have the chance to move up groups the following year.

HOYS Group Riders can email for an application form and return it by the 1st May 2016 to apply for the 2016 Master Class Selection Ride Off. Applications will be reviewed and approx 40 riders will be selected by June for the Ride Off and placed in the following groups. 10 riders per age group will be chosen for the selection Ride Off Rider 8 - 14 years / Rider 15 - 25 years / Rider 26 - 40 yrs / Rider 40 years & over  
(Age as of the 1st January in current year)

Selected Riders will be mentored by a showing expert with access to lots of help and advice in preparation for the Ride Off!

The Ride Off will take place at the TSR Gala Show on 16th & 17th July at Onley EC, Rugby. At the Ride off 1 Rider from each age group will be selected for the TSR/HOYS Showing Master Class to be held at HOYS.

### Am I eligible?

The class is open to all but the Pathway & Master Class is EXCLUSIVELY for AMATEUERS. Riders MUST be Amateurs as per the following and have not competed at HOYS in 2013,2014,2015 (inc 2016). Riders must not ride on a regular basis for owners or professional producers no matter if they are paid or not. The horse/pony must not have competed at the Horse of the Year Show in the past 3 years.

### **You are NOT an Amateur if:-**

Your main income is from working with horses or ponies either as a self-employed person or as an employee

You engage in breeding, livery, buying, selling or dealing in a commercial capacity.

Receive remuneration for employment in the connection with horses in racing, showing, livery or riding school (inc teaching)

Show a horse owned or sponsored by a company or commercial firm.

The horse/pony is stabled in a professional show producer's yard during the current season.

*You may keep your horse or pony at part livery or DIY Livery as long as the owner of the yard does not fall under the definition of Professional Show Producer. You may receive lessons / training in either a clinic or one to one basis.*

If you teach or train horses or riders on a paid or unpaid basis you are not eligible.

**Junior Riders under 18 years can only be classed as amateurs if both parents are amateurs.**

If you work with Horses /ponies but it is not your main income it must be on a ' hobby' basis and if this is the case you may have a ruling from the office on request. The definition by TSR of a Professional Show Producer is a person who derives income from keeping and training horses and ponies for the show ring even if this is not their sole or main source of income.
