RULES

Show jumping and dressage will be judged under Pony Club rules 2019. For dress and tack rules, please visit the Pony Club website.

Spurs are not allowed in any of the Working Hunter Classes.

A riding hat must be worn correctly and fastened at all times when mounted. Pony Club members must wear a hat that conforms with the Pony Club Hat rule and tagged with the Pony Club hat tag. Non members are strongly advised to wear a hat that conforms to pony club standards.

The organisers reserve the right to limit entries to any class and will accept entries on the field unless stated and only if space permits.

Entries for classes other than dressage may be taken on the field. The dressage must be pre entered to allow allocation of test times.

Trophies will be awarded to the highest placed Fife Pony Club Member and rosettes awarded 1-6th place.

Dressage times will be posted on the Documents Section of EquoEvents and on the Fife Pony Club website.

Show jumping heights are approximate and are maximum height first round.
