Rules & Conditions

All classes will be run in accordance with the latest BRC official rules.

All horses must have had at least their first two vaccinations, and not have had a vaccine within 7 days of the show

Correctly fitted hard hats to CURRENT recognised British standard must be worn & securely fastened when mounted, And strongly recommended for In Hand

Body protectors are strongly recommended.

In public areas of the show ground horses/ponies must be ridden/led at walk.

Please respect the hospitality of the landowners & take your litter home/use bins provided. Do not clean out your horse box/trailer on the field.

No refund of entry fees will be given.

The judge's decision is final & any objections must be handed to the secretary in writing with a £20 deposit, the deposit will be retained if the objection is not upheld.

Dogs must be kept on a short lead & under control at all times & all faeces picked up Horses & ponies must not be left unattended unless correctly secured inside the trailer/lorry.

Age as of January 1st 2019

Any horse/pony jumping as a horse/pony must do so for entire season.

Any person riding on a lead rein must do so for the rest of the event.

Non-members riding a member's horse must pay non-members entry fees.

No horse/pony under 4 years of age can be ridden on the show ground.

No responsibility can be taken for theft, loss, damage, accident or illness caused to persons/animals/property or vehicles attending this event.

All persons attending must have their own 3rd party liability insurance

The organisers of this event have taken every reasonable precaution to ensure the Health & Safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organiser and all official stewards.

TSR Showing Finals - This show is a qualifier for the TSR Showing Finals. Qualify and enter ANY of the Finals Central, East Anglia, North West, North East, South East, South, Wales & South West or Scottish. You Do Not have to be a TSR member to gualify or enter a final. The Rider/Handler gualifies and can enter any horse/pony in any number of Finals.

TSR Riders Finals – 1st & 2nd riders gualify and will receive a gualification card in the ring. TSR In Hand Finals – The two highest placed Handlers with a TSR In Hand Card will qualify in any In Hand class. Handlers MUST have their cards signed in the ring by the judge/steward, cards are FREE from the TSR website. Full details at www.theshowingregister.co.uk

RoR - Our Dressage and SJ classes will be RoR unaffiliated league qualifiers.

RoR- We will be running the RC challenge so RoR will award a rosette to the best RoR of the day Horses must have RoR competition membership.
