CLASS 4      NOVICE JUMPING 65cm (No fillers). Combination not to have won at 65cm Show Jumping.

CLASS 6      PAIRS 70cm Ride and Run (team of 2, one mounted, one on foot, both jumping the cours

CLASS 7      OPEN JUMPING 75cm (2'6")

CLASS 12      FIRST RIDDEN 12yrs &amp; under 13.2hh &amp; under

CLASS 13      FAMILY PONY Suitable for 2 or more members of same family not Exc. 15hh. May be led

CLASS 14      RIDDEN VETERAN. Horse or Pony 16yrs or over May be led

Section A)      9 yrs &amp; over – no lead reins

Section B)      8 yrs &amp; under - may be led with lead rein attached to noseband and leader at pony's shoulder.

No Whips or Spurs allowed in Gymkhana Games.

Points will be awarded in each race, and rosettes awarded to highest total points after all 4 races.

Handy Pony is a course of obstacles, designed to test the agility of pony and rider.

CLASS 19      FANCY DRESS - Theme - 90 Celebration      1pm      Entry Fee £3

**RING 5 WORKING HUNTER 9am Start****CLEAR ROUND WORKING HUNTER** - jumps approx. 65cm £3 per round at ring (2 rounds £5)**10 am**

CLASS 20 WORKING HUNTER PONY Not Exc 14.2HH

A) Jumps 60cm (2')

B) Jumps 75cm (2'6")

CLASS 21 WORKING HUNTER Exc 14.2hh

A) Jumps 75cm (2'6")

B) Jumps 85cm (2'9")

A & B is only for the jumping part, competitors chose the height they wish to jump. Showing section will be together, sections will only be split if sufficient entries.

Working Hunter Championship for 1st &amp; 2nd in classes 20 - 21 inc

There will be a special rosette for highest placed horse/pony in classes 20, 21 that hunts regularly. Written proof from Master/Hunt Secretary required on the day. Red armband to be worn

A) 10yrs &amp; under - Walk &amp; Trot Dressage Test 2013 -Jumps 45cm (1'3")

B) 17yrs &amp; under- Walk &amp; Trot Dressage Test 2013 -Jumps 55cm (1'9")

**Jumping for Class 24 will be in Ring 1 Show Jumps 12noon-1pm.**

Jumping faults will be added to your dressage penalty score.

CLASS 25 – COMBINED TRAINING Dressage 11.30am-2pm £12 on Day £20 (if not Full)

A) Pony Club Grassroots Dressage Test 2018 Jumps 70cm (2'3")

B) Pony Club Grassroots Dressage Test 2018 Jumps 85cm (2'9")

**Jumping for Class 25 in Ring 4.** Will be in the Working Hunter Arena starting not before 2pm. The jumps will be a mixture of Rustic and XC Style jumps. There will be a bogey time set at 375m/min. Jumping and time faults will be added to your dressage penalty score.

In the event of equality in scores, the higher place will go to, nearest to Optimum time.

1 <sup>st</sup> Fall of Rider	8 Penalties	Fall of Horse or 2 <sup>nd</sup> Fall of Rider	Elimination

## RULES

1. Hard Hats Must be worn with chinstrap fastened at all times when mounted.  
Hats must be Pony Club Approved and Tagged with an Aquamarine Pony Club, British Eventing (BE) or British Riding Club (BRC) Hat Tag. Hats standard: PAS015: 1998 or 2011 with BSI Kite mark, VG1 with BSI Kite mark, Snell E2001 with the official Snell label & number, ASTM-F1163 2004a onwards with the SEI mark, AS/NZS 3838 2006 onwards
2. Ages to be taken on the date of show 27.5.19
3. Organisers reserve the right to divide or amalgamate classes according to entries.
4. The committee reserve the right to refuse any entry made by any person, if they so shall deem it right to do so, without giving any reason.
5. The Judge's decision shall be final at all times
6. Wilton PC Challenge Cups will be held for 11 months and must be returned to the organiser. No cups will be released without being signed for by a parent or suitable adult. These cups are only awarded to the highest placed Wilton member in class.
7. Entries will not be refunded unless accompanied by a Vet or Doctor's certificate.
8. All Show jumping classes will run under the Pony Club rules for 2019
9. Working in for all classes, must be by competitor with a class entry on that pony.
10. Show Jumping Classes: Table A6: first round – not against the clock, those going clear in first round must go immediately to the jump off section of the course, against the clock.

### HEALTH & SAFETY
