



Arena Eventing Qualifying Shows

1st Nov, 22nd Nov, 3rd Jan, 17th Jan, 14th Feb



Class 1: Intro 70cm Sponsored by Midlands Horse Arenas

Combination not to have competed a BRC HT 80, 80AE or Eventer challenge in the current competition year.

Class 2: Novice 80cm Sponsored by Equestriana

Combination not to have competed at BE90, BRC HT 90, 90AE or Eventer Challenge in the current competition year.

Class 3: Intermediate 90cm

Combination not to have competed at BE100, BRC HT 100, 100AE or Eventer Challenge in the current competition year.

Class 3: Open 1m

Open to all

Pre Entry Only - £20

Start Fee - £5 per combination

The competition will consist of 6-7 show jumps followed immediately by 10 arena XC fences, all fences are knockdown.

XC section is set against an optimum time based on 350mpm.

XC attire to be worn including skull caps and body protectors, these must be to current safety standards.

Rosettes 1st-6th in each class

Prizes 1st-4th in each class

The top 10 scores from each class will qualify for the championship show held on 4th April 2021 with fantastic rosettes, sashes and prizes to be won.

Arena Eventing Rules

The competition will be one continuous round consisting of a mixture of Show jumps Cross-country fences. The time allowed is based on 325mpm.

On arrival please got to the secretary to collect your number, please take your hat and body protector for checking. A £5 start fee is payable on declaration.

The Individual with the lowest total score will win.

In the event of a tie;

- Clear rounds take precedence over jumping faults. I.e a rider with 4 time faults would be placed above a rider with 4 jumping faults.
- Nearest to optimum time

General Rules all Classes

Your horse must have up to date Influenza vaccinations in line with BRC Rule G7 in the current BRC Rulebook.

Horses/Ponies must be 4 years or older and cannot be entered in more than two classes on the same day.

Hat Standards

All hats must comply to the current safety standards , PAS015 or SEI ASTM F1163 04a onwards and SNELL E2001. Hats with a fixed peak are not permitted.

Body Protectors

A body protector is obligatory for this competition. A BETA level 3 (purple label) which has been manufactured in the year 2009 or Blue label 2018 must be worn. If a rider chooses to wear an airbag style body protector it must be worn over a permitted body protector and if activated must be deflated or removed before continuing. Hybrid air jackets are permitted. Riders wearing Exo Body Cage (2000) protectors must inform the secretary at all events.

The use of head cams is strictly prohibited. This includes use on the head, chest, bridle or any other part of the horse or rider.

No stop watches allowed. The competitors are not allowed to take mobile phones onto the course whilst competing.

Paper numbers will be used, so each rider will require a bib to display the number.

Tack and Dress Rules

Cross-Country attire to be worn.

Please make sure you adhere to tack and dress rules found in the current version of the BRC rules. The full 2019 version is available to download online.

Objections

Objections must be made in writing to the secretary within half an hour of the incident together with a £50 deposit. The deposit will be forfeited if the objection is not sustained. After this the score cannot be changed.
