COVID19 RULES AS FOLLOWS. NO EXCEPTIONS

We have to follow the ever changing covid19 situation & act accordingly to safeguard all competitors and staff on Show Day. We will do everything in our power to keep everyone safe at this Show. This means that TRACK AND TRACE MUST be complied with and details forwarded at TIME OF ENTRY. Please be aware that temperature spot checks will be made on arrival at the Show. Should you be unable to comply with any of the Covid19 Rules stated here do not attend this Show.

STRICTLY NO SPECTATORS OR MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL PUBLIC TO ATTEND.

- You will have to create your own number as a back/arm number or sticker or bridle number. You will be contacted prior to the show with your allocated number.
- Only 3 people per horse/pony (inc rider/handler) are allowed at the show.
- Pls provide Vehicle registration number and names of all attending persons (use NOTES/additional info box of Equo system) when entering.
- Do not attend this Show if you are feeling unwell and/or have covid19 symptoms.
- Do not arrive any earlier than one hour before your Class.
- Whilst NOT competing REMAIN IN YOUR LORRY/CAR.
- Class times will be timetabled and strictly adhered to.
- Entries will close midnight of Wednesday 28th October
- Show timetable will follow on Thursday 29th October

Class 1. Plaited SP/SHP/coloured Lead Rein Pony. under 128 cm.

Rider not to have attained 9th birthday before 1st January in current year.

Class 2. TINY TOTS Lead Rein Pony, plaited/M&M/coloured, under 128 cm,

Riders not to have attained their 7th birthday before 1st Jan in current year.

Class 3. TINY TOTS First Pony, M&M/plaited/traditional/coloured, under 128cms,

Riders not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st Jan in current year.

Class 4. M&M Lead Rein Pony. under 122 cm,

Rider not to have attained 9th birthday before 1st January in current year.

Class 5. ++NEW CLASS++ Home Produced Plaited or M&M Lead Rein Pony.

Pony and rider must meet the age & height criteria for one of the above Lead Rein Classes. Pony must not have been stabled in the yard of a professional Professional Producer or Trainer Yard since 1st Feb of the current year. Rider must not have ridden a pony for a Producer/Trainer since 1st Feb in current year. Pony must not be owned by anyone who has taken payment for Training or Producing ponies since 1st Jan of current year.

Class 6. Plaited Show Pony/Show Hunter Pony/Coloured First Ridden Pony under 128cm.

Rider not to have attained 10th birthday before 1st January in current year.

Class 7. STARTER Ridden Novice Plaited Pony/Horse, not exc 148cm, Go round in Walk and Trot only, Rider any age, optional canter in individual show, SNAFFLE BITS Only.

Class 8. Ridden Mxd Height Show Pony, not exc 148cm. Rider to be correct age for pony.

Class 9. M&M First Ridden Pony. Rider not to have attained 12th b'day before 1st Jan in current yr.

Class 10. ++NEW CLASS++ Home Produced Plaited or M&M First Ridden Pony.

Pony and rider must meet the age & height criteria for one of the above First Ridden Classes. Pony must not have been stabled in the yard of a professional Professional Producer or Trainer Yard since 1st Feb of the current year. Rider must not have ridden a pony for a Producer/Trainer since 1st Feb in current year. Pony must not be owned by anyone who has taken payment for Training or Producing ponies since 1st Jan of current year.

Class 11. Ridden Mxd Height Show Hunter Pony, not exc 153cm. Rider to be correct age for pony.

CHAMPIONSHIP, Classes 1 to 11, 1st PRIZE WINNERS eligible

Class 12. STARTER Ridden Novice Horse/Pony, Any Type, Go round in Walk and Trot only, Rider any age, optional canter in individual show, SNAFFLE BITS Only.

Class 13. Ridden Veteran. Horses/Ponies aged 15 years & over. Any height/type.

Class 14. Ridden Plaited Coloured Horse or Pony, Any Height. Rider any age.

Class 15. Ridden Native/Traditional/Hogged Coloured Horse or Pony, Any Height

Class 16. Ridden Traditional Solid Colour Cob, Any Height.

Class 17. STARTER Ridden Novice Horse/Plaited Pony, Snaffles Only, Go Round in Walk & Trot.

Class 18. Ridden Hunter, all weights.

Class 19. Ridden Riding Horse/Hogged Cob (may split if necessary)

Class 20. Ridden Thoroughbred/Ex Racer/Been Race Trained

Class 21, sml/large HT/RT Intermediate not exc 158cm. Rider must be correct age for mount.

CHAMPIONSHIP, Classes 12 to 21, 1st PRIZE WINNERS eligible

Class 22. STARTER Ridden Small Breeds M&M Pony, Snaffles Only. Go Round in Walk & Trot. **Rider any age**, optional canter in individual show, SNAFFLE BITS Only.

Class 23. STARTER Ridden Large Breeds M&M Pony, Snaffles Only. Go Round in Walk & Trot. **Rider any age**, optional canter in individual show, SNAFFLE BITS Only.

Class 24. Novice Ridden Small Breeds M&M, snaffles only.

Class 25. Novice Ridden Large Breeds M&M, snaffles only.

Class 26. Amateur Ridden M&M. Registered M&M pony ridden & owned by any age of rider who doesn't receive income from Training, schooling or breaking ponies & doesn't receive income from giving riding lessons and/or training. Ponies can be Novice or Open and the rider doesn't have to be the same person. Rider can be unrelated to Pony's owner. NB. Both Rider and Owner need to be Amateurs as defined above. Any bit. **++This is a new Class requested by competitors. ++**

Class 27. Junior Ridden M&M. Rider not to have attained 18th Birthday before 1st Jan in current yr.

Class 28. Open Ridden M&M. (may be split if entries warrant)

CHAMPIONSHIP, Classes 22 to 28, 1st PRIZE WINNERS eligible

RULES

*All persons entering, competing or otherwise taking part in the above show shall be considered as having read and accepted the following regulations.

*NO CHILD AGED UNDER 3 YEARS ON SHOW DAY MAY COMPETE

*Numbers to be collected from the Secretary on the Show Day

*Riding Hats to standard BSI PAS015 1998, EN13841996, ASTM F1163, SNELLE2001, AS/NZS3838 1998, 2003, SAI GLOBAL must be worn at all times with the chinstrap fastened when mounted

*The Show organisers hold no responsibility for any accident occurring at this show.

*Horse Riding is a riskful sport, and you compete at your own risk.

*Horses must be four years old and over in all the ridden classes.

*Horses/Ponies DO NOT REQUIRE a JMB Height certificate.

*Any suitable bridles may be worn and handles on saddles in the Lead Rein are permitted.

*Spurs can only be worn when riding a horse exceeding 148cms. No Spur Rowels allowed.

*Spurs are not allowed in any Mountain & Moorland Classes.

*Stallions/Colts MUST be handled by persons aged 16 years and over AT ALL TIMES and must not be left unattended at any time **STALLIONS MUST WEAR STALLION DISCS.**

*Any fall of horse/pony/rider in the class will result in immediate disqualification and they must leave the ring without re-mounting.

*Whips not to exceed 75cm (30”).

*The Judge’s decision is final.

* An exhibitor must not exhibit a horse/pony bred, sold, leased or produced by the Judge, his/her immediate family or his/her employer.

*An exhibitor may not show under a Judge for whom he/she has produced a horse/pony in the same year.

*A rider may not ride in a class judged by someone for whom he/she has ridden in a competition during the current year.

*Competitors may be photographed for Sparket Equestrian Events Publicity in Newspapers, Magazines, Face Book and other media forms on Show Days. By taking part in any Sparket Equestrian Event competitors agree to being photographed for publicity purposes.

*Horse Riding can be a dangerous activity. Newton Rigg EC and/or Sparket Equestrian Events cannot be held responsible for libelous actions at his event by competitors or otherwise.

Ridden Warm Up is available on completion of In Hand Classes.

*PLEASE NOTE NO LUNGING AT ANY TIME in car park or arena.

*Anyone found to be misusing or abusing any person or animal (including horses) will be EVICTED from the premises IMMEDIATELY with no appeal.

*The use of side or running or draw reins is forbidden at any time.

*Please note that all Horses/Ponies at this event MUST be vaccinated for Equine Flu on a 12 month basis.

* Any objections must be forwarded to the Secretary with £40 cash and a signed letter of complaint. Should the complaint be upheld the £40 cash will be returned to the objector.

- **Pls provide Vehicle registration number and names of all attending persons (use NOTES/additional info box of Equo system) when entering.**
- **Do not attend this Show if you are feeling unwell and/or have covid19 symptoms.**
- **Class times and Warm Up times will be timetabled and strictly adhered to.**
- **Whilst NOT competing REMAIN IN YOUR LORRY/CAR.**
