DATA PROTECTION

By entering any class through Equo Events, you agree to the following:

EQUINE INFLUENZA VACCINATIONS

Following consultation with our veterinary advisors and equestrian governing bodies, Blair Castle Horse Trials has made the decision that

All horses and ponies entering the venue this year must be vaccinated against equine influenza according to standard British Horseracing Association guideline, with the last vaccination having been administered no more than 365 days prior to entry to the venue.

- All animals must have completed the primary course of two vaccinations. The last vaccination must have been administered at least 7 days before entering the venue.
- Horses competing under FEI rules or British Eventing rules must abide by the vaccination rules of that Governing Body.
- Foals under six months of age will be exempt from the vaccination requirement.

Random passport checks will be implemented to verify vaccination status.

Any animal identified without a valid vaccination protocol or if the owner/rider is unable to produce a valid passport will result in immediate ejection of that animal from the venue. No refunds will be issued in respect of entries or stabling.

1. STABLING

A limited number of stables are available for competitors. Stables will be available from Wednesday 25th – Sunday 29th August 2021 inclusive.

Stabling options for 2021

- Wednesday duration stable Price: £165 (including VAT)
Boxes will be available from 4pm on Wednesday 25th August until Sunday 29th August 2021.
- Thursday duration stable Price: £145 (including VAT)
Boxes will be available from 4pm on Thursday 26th August until Sunday 29th August.
- Single night stable Price: £65 (including VAT) per night
Wednesday night, Thursday night, Friday night or Saturday night.
If the stable is booked for one night only it will be available from 4pm on the day booked and **must** be vacated and mucked out by 2pm the following day.

All stables have to be booked via Equo Events (www.equoevents.co.uk), no stabling bookings will be accepted by phone or email.

Stabling will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis. Applications open on the 7th June 2021. Applications received prior to this date will NOT be accepted.

Bookings close 2nd August 2021, or when all stables are filled.

Strictly **no** applications will be accepted after this date.

No refunds will be given for stabling cancelled after the closing date. Stabling applications will **not** be secured until payment has been received.

Please contact the Horse Trials Office if you need to resell your stable. Competitors are **not** permitted to sublet stables or resell stables without prior written permission from the Organisers. This is to ensure we have the correct contact details in case of veterinary emergencies.

Straw is supplied for bedding; competitors requiring shavings are welcome to bring their own or purchase them at the event. Hay and mucking out tools are not supplied. **All stables MUST be vacated and mucked out by 2pm on the day of departure.**

Stabling will be accepted with valid entry to one of the Land Rover Blair Castle Horse Trials satellite competitions.

Please ensure that **the correct postal address is in the system of Equo Events prior booking**, as we will send the pack of passes and wristbands to that address.

Please keep the Horse Trials Office informed prior to the Event, and the Stable Manager during the Event, **if there is any change of the owner of your stable. We need at least one appropriate contact with a mobile phone number in case of emergency.**

2. CHILDREN

Children under the age of 16 must be supervised by an adult whilst in the stabling area.

3. CURFEW

There is a curfew on riding of 7pm throughout the event. This includes warm-up arenas and hacking as well as competition arenas. Horses and ponies may still be exercised in-hand or lunged after this time.

Anyone found riding after curfew may be asked to leave the venue. No refunds will be given for stabling or entry fees.

4. CAMPING

Only competitors who have booked stables are permitted to stay overnight in their horseboxes. Competitors who have not booked stabling must leave the showground at the end of the show day. Horses may not be kept in horseboxes overnight.

Pens are not permitted overnight or during the day. Anyone erecting pens will be asked to remove them.

Excluding competitors staying in their horsebox, there is no camping permitted in the lorry parking.

Each booking comes with ONE vehicle pass for your horsebox or car and trailer. Any vehicles without the correct pass will be redirected to Car Park 1, where they will be required to purchase parking.

There is no camping permitted in Car Park 1.

For those who have booked stabling for the night prior to their competition day, access to the site will be possible from 4pm the day before your competition.

ALL Competitors, Riders and Owners **must** obey the instructions to enter and leave the site and follow the directions given for horsebox parking by the stewards and officials in charge of this area.

To comply with the Fire Services' instructions, if you are sleeping in your trailer/lorry, there **must** be a **4metre gap** in each direction from your trailer/horsebox.

It is **not** permitted to erect a tent in the lorry parking. Please note, there is no electrical hook-up in the lorry parking.

Diesel generators are permitted, providing they are correctly earthed and fuel is safely stored. The Organisers may check generators and remove any deemed unsafe. Generators should not be run during Quiet Hours. **Petrol generators are not allowed under any circumstances.**

Campers are requested to respect other guests and keep noise (including generator noise) to a reasonable level – Quiet Hours will be in effect between 11pm and 7am.

5. ADMISSION

Wristbands and passes will be issued according to the entries and stabling booking.

Competitors will be issued two wristbands for the first entered horse and one additional wristband for each horse thereafter. One additional wristband will be issued for each rider under the age of 16 years for an accompanying adult. Wristbands will be valid for the days you are competing only.

All further admission tickets and wristbands must be purchased in advance via the box office at www.blairhorsetrials.co.uk/box-office. Owing to Covid-19 safety restrictions, there are a limited number of tickets available this year.

One vehicle pass will be issued per one or two entered horses. Additional vehicles must park in the public car park.

6. HORSE WELFARE

Land Rover Blair Castle International Horse Trials is committed to the health and safety of equine athletes. Please read the Blair Castle Horse Welfare Policy, which can be found on the website,

The Organisers of the Land Rover Blair Castle International Horse Trials reserve the right to eliminate competitors if in the opinion of an event official or vet a rider is an inappropriate weight for the horse or pony. This includes riding in the collecting rings and exercise areas.

7. DOPING TEST

The Organisers reserve the right to have any animal tested.

8. DISEASE

Any animal found suffering from a contagious or infectious disease **must** be removed from the Showground immediately at the request of the Veterinary Surgeon, along with any animal from the same yard or that have travelled together to the Show.

9. CONTROL OF ANIMALS

Any competitor/owner who cannot adequately control their animal may be required to immediately leave the showground, on the direction of an Official. No refunds will be issued in respect of entries or stabling.

10. DOGS

Dogs **must** be on a lead and under control at all times whilst on the Showground, in the Stabling, Campsite and parking areas.

Owners **must** clean up after their dogs. Free bags are available from the Stable Manager's Office and from the Information Tent. Owners whose dogs are found loose or fouling without cleaning up will incur £10 fines which will be donated to the Event Official Charity.

11. LIABILITY

Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the Organisers or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the Organisers, Atholl Estates, Blair Castle Estate Ltd, nor any Agent, employee or representative of these bodies accept any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury, illness to horses, riders, owners, grooms, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any person or property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any way whatsoever.

12. INSURANCES

All owners and competitors are personally responsible for damages to third parties caused by themselves, their employees, their agents or their animals. They are therefore strongly advised to take out a third-party insurance providing full coverage for participation in equestrian events at home and abroad and to **keep the policy up to date**.

13. LOSS OR DAMAGE

The Organisers accept no responsibility whatsoever for loss, injury or damage, however caused, to any person, animal or property in the Showground, in stables or in car parks.

14. COVID-19

ALL competitors will be expected to check and comply with the latest Covid-19 legal requirements, Covid-19 safety measures at the Event available on the website, as well as the Covid-19 sporting protocols of their class or competition's Governing Body.
