PRICES EXCLUDE THE APHS Foreign Breed Festival National Finals (In Hand & Ridden), the Veteran Finalé & the JRL Champion of Champions (all held at our September Show) – entry fees for these are £10 per Final. Qualifying cards MUST be submitted (one card per horse for each Final). Awards to all forward in the finals.

#### ALL SHOWS

- All shows will be CAPPED class sizes will be dependent on size of ring, type of class and whether Covid restrictions are in place (& if so, dependent on the latest Government Guidelines/Regulations).
- At our Spring Show our classes MAY be capped at between 12 & 15 horses per class. If more entries are received than this for any one class, then the class will be split and "go rounds" will be held and each division will be pinned 1<sup>st</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> place, with sashes for the winners. Each winner will be eligible to go forward to their respective championship.
- In classes where we are pinning pure and partbreds separately, if the class number size has not been reached, then the class will be run together and the awards pinned separately at the end. If class numbers exceed the capped class size (at time of close of entries), then the partbred section will be run after the purebred section. If we have sufficient numbers of individual breeds pre-entered in the Iberian/Baroque, USA Breeds & Fjord/Haflinger In Hand classes (classes 2, 3, 7, 21 & 24) then we will judge the breeds separately and class will be split into separate classes and run as described above.
- We will post a more detailed timetable after close of entries on our Facebook Group (APHS London Counties Show) showing any splits that are occurring. We will only split the classes based on pre-entries, even if additional entries are taken on the day. (As we have to book an additional judge in advance).
- For both our In Hand and our Ridden Championships, we will have separate divisions in both for pure and partbreds.
- **Our Open Breed classes (classes 13 to 17)** are open to ANY breed of horse or pony, not just foreign breeds. Where restrictions have been placed on the entry requirements for these classes, they do NOT apply to any Youth rider (18 years or under). Any youth class winner will also receive a keepsake trophy in their class(es).
- **Dressage Classes** (classes 32 to 36) will start at 12pm and run on from one another. Advance entries only for these Dressage classes. The Dressage classes will run in the order shown, so please bear this in mind when booking your classes. Dressage classes are open to ANY BREED (not just foreign breed).

#### Spring Show (1<sup>st</sup> May at Northcote Stud).

- Normal Conditions this will be both indoors & outdoor (both on surface, Ring 1 indoors & Ring 2 outdoors) and the outside ring will be also be sectioned off and available for warm up.
- If run under Covid conditions then class sizes may be reduced.
- Parking will be on hard standing.
- Café/catering on site (will be take away service if Covid Restrictions are in force).
- 17 Overnight Stables and Hook-Ups are available (book directly with Northcote Stud at <u>www.northcotestud.com</u>)
- Entries will be via Equoevents, advance entries only. Catalogued horses can enter additional classes on the day if classes are not full (premium applies).

In the event of US having to cancel ANY of our events due to COVID then all entry fees will be refunded in full, less any administration fees (which are deducted by Stripe/Equoevents before they are sent to us).

Class 1.	Foreign Breed In Hand Lightweight/Refined Types, any age or sex. Purebreds will be pinned separately to Partbreds.
Class 2.	Iberian & Baroque Breeds In Hand, any age or sex. Purebreds will be pinned separately to Partbreds. Open to all Iberian & Baroque Breeds – PREs, PReMs, PSL (Lusitanos), Cruzados, Friesian, Warlander, Knabstrupper etc.
Class 3.	<b>USA Breeds In Hand</b> , any age or sex. Purebreds will be pinned separately to Partbreds. Open to any north American breed - Morgans, Saddlebreds, QH, Paints, Standardbreds, RMH, Appaloosas etc.
Class 4	Foreign Breed In Hand Middleweight/Heavyweight Types, any age or sex. Purebreds will be pinned separately to Partbreds.
Class 5.	Foreign Breed Youngstock In Hand, 3 years or under, any sex. Purebreds will be pinned separately to Partbreds.
Class 6	<b>Foreign Breed Veterans In Hand</b> , 15 years or over, open to both pure and partbreds. Top 2 qualify for the APHS Veteran Finalé.
Class 7	Foreign Breeds Amateur Owned, Trained & Shown In Hand, any age or sex, open to both pure and partbreds. Manners a major consideration in this class and count for 50% of the overall marks.
Class 8	Arabs In Hand, any age or sex. Purebreds will be pinned separately to Partbreds.
Class 9	Fjord & Haflinger In Hand, any age or sex.
Class 10	Foreign Breeds Mares & Fillies In Hand, any age. Purebreds will be pinned separately to Partbreds.
Class 11	Foreign Breeds Geldings In Hand, any age. Purebreds will be pinned separately to Partbreds.

Class 12 Foreign Breeds Stallions & Colts In Hand, any age. Purebreds will be pinned separately to Partbreds.

#### FOREIGN BREEDS IN HAND CHAMPIONSHIP:

- **PUREBRED**: Open to 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> from above 12 classes, providing horse is PUREBRED. Championship rosettes to Champion, Reserve & Second Reserve.
- **PARTBRED**: Open to 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> from above 12 classes, providing horse is PARTBRED. Championship rosettes to Champion, Reserve & Second Reserve.

#### RING 1 JUDGE TBC

**CLASSES 13 – 17: OPEN TO** <u>ANY</u> **BREED (not just foreign breeds).** Enter the ring at walk on the left rein & proceed as directed by the judge. Any tack is permissible, including training tack and horses may be led (off the noseband). Conformation will not be considered in these classes UNLESS it impinges on the horses' way of going.

13.	Youth Walk/Trot, riders aged 14 years & under. Shown at walk & trot only, no individual show. Lead Lines welcome – must be led off the noseband. Open to any breed of horse/pony. (No height restriction on horses). Keepsake trophy for the winner. Entry fee for this class £10. Top 2 qualify for the APHS Junior Ridden Championships.
14.	<b>Open Walk/Trot</b> – riders any age, shown at walk & trot only. No individual show. Lead Lines are welcome in this class – must be led off the noseband. Open to any breed of horse/pony.
15.	<b>Open Ridden Class</b> , riders may be of any age. Open to any breed of horse/pony. Will be expected to walk, trot and canter. No individual show.
16.	<b>Champagne Class</b> , riders may be of any age. Open to any breed of horse/pony. Will be expected to walk, trot and canter. No individual show. You hold a glass of wine in one hand, and your reins in the other and perform the gaits as called out by the judge. The one with the most wine left in their glass at the end of the class is the winner. This is a fun class. Entry fee for this class £10.
17.	<b>Open Concours Class</b> , riders may be of any age. Open to any breed of horse/pony. Can be shown in hand or ridden (lead reins welcome). Walk & Trot only.

RIDDEN. Any show tack is allowed (e.g. English, saddle seat, side saddle, western, Portuguese, Spanish etc.) in classes 18 to 31, unless specified otherwise. Please enter the ring at trot (or equivalent) for these classes on the left rein & proceed as directed by the judge. No individual show is required in classes 18 to 31. Winners from classes 1 – 12 and 18 – 38 qualify for the APHS Foreign Breed National Finals in September (in hand winners qualify for the In Hand Finals and Ridden winners qualify for the Ridden Finals). Cards may be handed down the line, no lower than 4<sup>th</sup> place, if the winner has already qualified. - Foreign Breeds any breed that is non-indigenous to GB, Northern Ireland & Eire (e.g. Irish horses are NOT eligible, unless they are partbreds crossed with a Foreign Breed). Warmbloods ARE eligible to take part in foreign breed classes.
- Foreign Breed classes open to pure & partbred (min. 25%), unless schedule says otherwise.
- The APHS-Foreign Breed Showing National Finals Foreign Breed of the Year Championships are held within Autumn Show. Horses only need to qualify to take part in the Final Championships at this event (C3 – C6) – other classes at this event NO qualification needed.
- All foreign breed classes at all our events will be judged under APHS Rules, published as USA-UK Show Rules (available on our website or at: <u>www.american-saddlebred.co.uk</u>). Please also see "Judging Foreign Breeds" © - can be viewed either at the USAUK website, or at the APHS Website.
- The judge will not ride in any class, apart from our RoR classes in July. (Judge will NOT ride if the event is being run under Covid Rules). Individual shows are NOT required in the Foreign Breed classes at any of our events.
- ADDITIONAL COVID RULES MAY BE APPLICABLE SEE WEBSITE & FACEBOOK GROUP FOR UP TO DATE DETAILS.
- Stallions and colts welcome but should be bitted and under control and to be shown by adults. N.B. Stock horses may be shown in a stock halter with
  a properly secured chain; Iberian horses in a serrata (with a throat lash); Arabs & Miniatures in a show halter etc. including stallions BUT they
  must be under control. The judge, steward, or any show official, may excuse a horse from the ring if they deem the handler does not have full control,
  or if they feel they are of danger to other exhibitors, or they can request that the horse is bitted for subsequent classes.
- Refunds are not given without a doctors or vets certificate please note any PayPal, bank or Stripe fees will be deducted from refunds. Credit notes may be given in other circumstances at the Organisers discretion.
- Veteran classes: May (Spring) & June (Solstice) Show are VHS GOLD TICKETS for the current year these will be awarded to the two highest placed registered horses in both classes (who must be registered with their appropriate breed society) who will qualify for the VHS Supreme Championships in October (In hand or ridden as appropriate). July Show the Veteran classes are AREA Qualifiers (first round).
- All APHS events are both HOPE Best of the Best & Royal London Show qualifiers see our website for full description and eligibility. Our JULY show (London Counties) is also usually a qualifier for TGCA, BSPA, CHAPS, Sunshine Tour, Equifest, VHS please see website for up to date list.
- OPEN classes are open to ANY breed of horse/pony (not restricted to Foreign Breeds).
- Timings: allow approx. 15 mins a class for Walk/Trot classes, 20 mins a class for Foreign Breed classes and 30 mins a class for Open Breed classes. Please keep an eye on your rings. It is YOUR responsibility to be in time for your class. If you MISS a class we will not issue a refund.
- Ridden classes horses or ponies in ridden classes must be at least 4 years of age.
- Ponies/Horses being led in the walk/trot and youth classes (where allowed) MUST be led off the noseband. Lead line welcome in any Walk/Trot or Concours classes.
- Training tack can comprise of martingales or Market Harlborough (used on a snaffle rein), flash/grackle noseband (used with a snaffle bit).
- Horses should be turned out correct for their breed (with full mane & tail if correct), in all classes.
- Current Safety Hats MUST be worn at all times when mounted. Junior exhibitors (under 18) MUST wear these hats in ALL classes, including in hand. Adult riders should ensure that the Secretary is in possession of a Disclaimer Form for any non-safety conforming headgear that they choose to wear. A copy of the required wording is shown within. Exhibitors may wear approved safety hats (& jackets) in any class without penalty. Entering online indicates acceptance of ALL show and venue rules
- No claim can be entertained for anything that may happen to competitors, onlookers, their property, servants or horses in connection with or arising
  out of the show. It shall be deemed a condition of entry that each entrant shall agree to indemnify the Promoters against any legal action arising out
  of any incident and to agree to abide by the rules and regulations of the show and the Showground.
- All competitors must have adequate insurance to cover any incident that may be caused by them or their animals.
- Dogs welcome but must be kept on a lead please clear up after your pooch! NO dogs allowed in the indoor gallery or eating areas.
- Please take all rubbish home. Do NOT muck out horse boxes/trailers in the lorry parks. Please clear up around your parked lorries/trailers (horse poo, hay etc.).
- Although every effort will be made to adhere to the printed schedule, the Organisers reserve the right to combine, cancel or change the running order of classes on the day or implement a change of judges if the needs arise and to refuse entry (to competitors, spectators or their guests) without specifying the reason.
- Please note that all rings run concurrently and so classes MAY clash bear this in mind when making your entries & please watch your rings. It is the policy of this show NOT to forward trophies (where presented) by post, so please check at the Secretary's Desk before going home!
