#### ***Championship qualification***

Any competitor coming 1<sup>st</sup> – 3<sup>rd</sup> in our April, June or October classes automatically qualifies for the championship show on the 4<sup>th</sup> December where we will have bigger and better rosettes and prizes for our champions and reserve champions!!

#### ***Points mean prizes***

Any competitor coming 1<sup>st</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> in our April, June, October & December classes will gain points (1<sup>st</sup> = 6, 2<sup>nd</sup> = 5, 3<sup>rd</sup> = 4, 4<sup>th</sup> = 3, 5<sup>th</sup> = 2 and 6<sup>th</sup> = 1). The riders with the most points will win a rosette at the end of the year (1<sup>st</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup>)

## GENERAL RULES AND CONDITIONS

1. Everyone mounted, whether competitor or not, shall wear a hard hat to at least the minimum standard, with a harness properly adjusted and fastened. Failure to do so will incur elimination. Hats marked PAS 015 and prefixed ASTM or SEI are the minimum standard allowed.
2. Long hair should be worn in a net or secured in such a way as not to hang lower than the shoulder line.
3. Gloves are compulsory for dressage
4. A horse or pony may compete from 1 Jan in the year that it becomes 4 years old.
5. The organisers reserve the right to cancel the event, alter classes, times or any other published information. In the event of cancellation all fees will be refunded less 15%
6. Unless explicitly stated to the contrary, medical facilities on the showground will be limited to standard NHS accident and emergency callout
