PLEASE READ AND ABIDE BY ALL THE RULES

CLASSES

Class 1: Eventers challenge (30cm) £15 (can be lead and or assisted, cross country in enclosed grass arena)

Class 2: Eventers challenge (40cm) £15 (can be lead and or assisted, cross country in enclosed grass arena)

Class 3: Eventers challenge (50cm) £20

Class 4: Eventers challenge (60cm) £20

Class 5: Eventers challenge (70cm) £20

Class 6: Eventers challenge (80 cm) £20

The heights in all XC phases are a **maximum**; the course will include fences below this height.

Closing date for entries will be Wednesday 10th August, times will published on our facebook page and on Equo in the information section.

What is an Eventers Challenge?

A 2 Phase horse trial, the first section is over show jumps and the second is timed over natural obstacles. The show jump phase will be approx. 10 jumps, followed immediately by 10-12 cross country jumps on the main cross country course. The cross country for classes 1 & 2 will take place within an enclosed arena, also on grass.

After the show jumps competitors must enter the start box and wait for the bell before beginning the 2nd phase over natural obstacles. A section of the cross country phase will be timed, and may include knock down fences, which will ensure penalties (10 penalties). Overall the winner and runners up will be those that achieve clear round in both phases with the fastest time over the cross county phase. Start times will be allocated to all competitors.

NB. At this event, if you are eliminated SJ, we may allow you to continue onto XC at the judges discretion, but anyone eliminated XC will have to leave the course at a walk allowing others to continue safely.

Payment Details & Event Fees

Entries in advance via EQUO EVENTS.

Eventers Challenge: £15 per class or £20 per class height dependant (a small additional booking fee will be payable to Equo Events)

All shows will be attended by a First Aider. First aid charges are included within the class entry fees. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Show Secretary, late entries will incur an additional £2 late entry charge per class.

Prize Information

Rosettes to 6th place and trophies to winners.

Dress

Cross country colours or show jackets

Medical armbands and back protectors are compulsory. Competitors must provide their own number bibs and medical armbands. Second hand number bibs are available to purchase from the secretaries tent for £5.

Course Walking

The courses will be available to walk from 2pm the day before the competition.

Terms & Conditions

1. The event is run under Pony Club Eventing Rules 2015. Please read the rules, which can be downloaded from the Pony Club website, before entering, and abide by them at all times. The rules will have the following exceptions:
 - a. If you have three refusals at one fence you may go on, at the Judge's/Steward's discretion.
 - b. If you are eliminated in the Show Jumping you may go on to the Cross Country phase ONLY IF you have the permission of the Show Jumping Judge that you are safe to continue (whose decision is final).
2. A horse/pony may only be entered in one class and ridden once, the only exception to this is that a horse / pony may compete in a second mini class with a second rider. All horses/ponies must be 5 years old or over. No stallions.
3. MEDICAL ARMBANDS and BODY PROTECTORS are compulsory for cross-country and body protectors are advised for show jumping. Riders wearing body cages must leave a key with the secretary before going cross country.
4. A fastened hat must be worn at all times when mounted . Please ensure you are wearing a hat that conforms to the 2016 standards. If in doubt, please refer to the Pony club website http://www.pcuk.org/uploads/dcs/Hat_Rule_2016_FV.pdf . All hats must be tagged as conforming to the pony club / Riding Club standards. This will be checked before the dressage – take any untagged hats to the secretary beforehand. There will be a charge of £1 for hats to be tagged. A fastened hat must be worn at all times when mounted.
5. Any competitor who has a fall or sustains a serious injury anywhere at the competition site must see medical personnel on the day and be passed fit to ride before riding that horse in a further test or before riding any other horse. Any competitor having a fall injury needs to report to the Secretary to have the fall logged in the Accident log.
6. Objections may be lodged, in writing, to the Secretary with a £10 deposit within 10 minutes of the publication of the results for that class.
7. Excessive use of whip or spurs will result in disqualification, the judges decision is final.
8. All withdrawals must be made by the closing date. Tumpy Green is only required to repay 50% of entry fees in respect of all entry cancellation received by the Show Secretary no later than 48hours before noon of the day on which the first class is scheduled to start. Later cancellations received by the Show Secretary will not be refunded or transferred, including on-the-day entries.
9. If cancelled, £5.00 will be retained from the entry fee; the balance will be paid in June on receipt of a stamped addressed envelope.
10. All dogs must be kept on a short lead.
11. Please do not muck out lorries/trailers in the car park and take all litter home.
12. The Judges decision is final.
13. Health, safety and welfare: The organisers have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present at this event. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents. They must obey the instructions of the organisers and all officials and stewards.
14. Legal liability: Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club/ The Riding Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other personal property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.
