Show Rules and Conditions

THIS SHOW WILL BE RUN UNDER THE LATEST COVID RULES AT THE TIME OF THE SHOW.HEALTH AND SAFETY.

This show is run with due regard to Health and Safety. The primary contact on the day will be Mr. C. Yates. It is in the best interests of all exhibitors and spectators that they comply with any Show Official which pertains to Health and Safety matters. Any accident must be reported as soon as possible. First Aiders will be on duty for all classes.

Neither the BSPS or any of its officers, assistants or stewards shall in anyway be responsible for any loss, injury or damage that may happen to exhibitors or their assistants or other members of the public, or to any animal property or to any vehicle brought onto the Showground or on any premises used in conjunction with the Show, or while entering or leaving the same.

****IT IS NECESSARY ALL EXHIBITORS CARRY PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE FOR AN ADEQUATE INDEMNITY TO PROTECT AGAINST THEIR NEGLIGENCE INCLUDING ANY INJURY CAUSED BY THEIR ANIMALS OR PROPERTY.**

1.Any horse/pony which is not under complete control or in any way constitutes a danger will be asked to leave the Showground. Horses/ponies are not allowed to be ridden other than at a WALK except in the rings and working in areas.

2.Dogs – NO DOGS ALLOWED ON THE SHOWGROUND

3.Neither the organizers nor the owners of the property will be responsible or liable for any loss, accident or damage to any persons to or their property

4. THE DIRECTORS OF AREA 15 LIMITED RESERVE THE RIGHT TO REFUSE OR ACCEPT ENTRIES AT THEIR COMPLETE DISCRETION.

5.All horses/ponies must be 4 years of age

6.Only tack that is permissible in the ring in BSPS classes is allowed to be used on the showground

7.Only Horses/ponies competing at the Show are allowed on the showground.

8. No mucking out of horses boxes on the showground and all rubbish taken home

9.NO LUNGING ON THE SHOWGROUND

10. BODY PROTECTORS – MUST BE COMPLIANT WITH RULE 50 IN THE 2024 BSPS

RULE BOOK. They MUST be worn when jumping in any WHP & WH classes inc. Practice ring at BSPS Affiliated Shows (Including Tiny Tots, Cradle & Nursery Stakes. WSP/RWSP and Training Stakes. Riders must wear a body protector when working in (practice jumps) and the jumping phase in all BSPS organised or affiliated events. The British Trade Association (BETA) approved and appropriately labelled “ Level 3 body protector” 2018 (Blue and Black) shown on the label. The BETA recommends body protectors are replaced every three to five years, which the impact absorption properties of the foam may have started to decline. All types AIR JACKETS are NOT allowed.

11. HAT- UP DATE Correctly secured skull caps/riding hats Nos. PASO15 2011,

VGI,(BS) EN 1384 2023, ASTM F1163 2015 and 2023, SNELL E2016 and E2021,

AS/NZS 3838 2006 MUST be compliant with RULE 43 in THE BSPS 2024 RULE

BOOK and MUST be worn by riders at all times when mounted. Hats should have a plain cover either black, blue, brown, grey or green velvet covers are encouraged. The BSPS encourages members to have their hats tagged through the BSPS scheme or via the Pony Club Scheme. Tagging indicates that the hat meets the accepted standards, no check of the fit or condition of the hat is implied. It is considered the responsibility of the members/guardians to ensure the hat complies with the current standards and is tagged before they complete. Members/guardians are responsible for ensuring the manufacturer’s guidelines with regard to the fit and replacement are followed.

This show is affiliated to the British Show Pony Society competing, showing or otherwise taking part in BSPS classes, whether or not members of the BSPS are subject to the Constitution and Rules of the BSPS, including disciplinary procedures and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the BSPS. Owners and riders must be BSPS Members before the date of the show to compete to qualify in classes with qualification for BLUE RIBBAND, RIHS (including Pretty Polly) qualifying classes and animals must be registered with the BSPS, except for the ANGLO and Part Bred Arabs who must be registered with the AHS. Membership forms and payment must be received in the office no later than the last working day (Monday to Friday) prior to the date of the qualifying show, (see Rule 20 see also 522). This show is a qualifier for the BSPS Championship Show

THIS SHOW IS A QUALIFIER FOR THE ROYAL INTERNATIONAL HORSE SHOW

Only one pony in each of the Open Working Hunter Pony 133cm/143cm/153cm classes and in the Open Intermediate WHP class and the Open Nursery Stakes classes will qualify. The highest placed (not already qualified) from the first **THREE** ponies placed in each class will qualify. **N.B THE R.I.H.S QUALIFICATION IS SUBJECT TO CONFIRMATION FROM BSPS HEAD OFFICE.**

Class 2 BSPS RIHS OPEN WHP – Mare or Gelding 4 years old or over exceeding 143cms and not exceeding 153cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 20th birthday before the 1st January in the current year. SOUTHVIEW SPARKS Memorial trophy to the highest placed Area 15 Member. Presented by Mr. W. Hills. The winner qualifies for **“THE BINKS FAMILY”** Champion of Champions

Class 3. BSPS RIHS OPEN WHP – Mare or gelding 4 years old or over exceeding 133ms and not exceeding 143cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 17th birthday by the 1st January in the current year. The winner qualifies for **“THE BINKS FAMILY”** Champion of Champions

Class 4. BSPS RIHS OPEN WHP - Mare or gelding 4 years old or over not exceeding 133cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 14th birthday by the 1st January in the current year. The winner qualifies for **“THE BINKS FAMILY”** Champion of Champions

THE BSPS WHP CHAMPIONSHIP – 1st and 2nd prize winners from classes 1-4 Qualify. **THE HUNNABLE SALVER** to the winner. **SPONSORED BY “ESSEX & SUFFOLK EQUINE VETS”**

Class 5. BSPS RIHS OPEN NURSERY STAKES – Mare or gelding 4 years old or over not exceeding 133cms.
