Dressage test – Introductory B (2009)

Approx. height of fences – 50 cm

Dressage will be on grass, Showjumping on the all-weather arena and the Cross Country will be held in our mini arena

Entry fee - £28

Class 2a – 60cm – Novice - May be assisted/ Dressage may be called

Dressage test – Prelim 7 (2002)

Approx. height of fences – 60 cm

Dressage will be held on our mini arena, Showjumping will be on the all-weather arena, and XC on our mini arena

Entry fee - £28

Class 2b – 60-65cm Open

Dressage test – Prelim 7 (2002)

Approx. height of fences – 60 cm

Dressage will be held on grass, Showjumping on the all- weather arena, and Cross Country will be held on the main course

Approx. height of fences – 60cm

Entry fee- £31

Class 3a – 70cm – 15 yrs and under - May be assisted/ Dressage may be called

3b – 70 cm Open

Dressage test – Prelim 18 (2002)

Approx. height of fences – 70cm

Dressage will be on grass, Showjumping on the all-weather arena and the Cross Country will be on the main course

Entry fee - £35

Class 4 – 80cm open

Dressage test - BE 95 (2012)

Approx. height of fences – 80cm

Dressage will be on grass, Showjumping on the all-weather arena and the Cross Country will be on the main course

Entry fee - £35

Class 5 – 90cm open

Dressage test – BE 106 (2012)

Approx. height of fences – 90cm

Dressage will be on grass, Showjumping on the all-weather arena and the Cross Country will be on the main course

Entry fee - £35

Scoring – as per riding club horse trials

The course may be walked Friday 4th August between 2pm and 6pm

Rules - Hats to PAS015 and must have a BSI kite mark (as per new rules) must be worn when mounted
A body protector to BETA Level 3 manufactured in 2000 or after must be worn for the XC phase and is recommended for the Showjumping phase

Times will be emailed and placed on Facebook on Friday 4th August.

Eliminated competitors must leave the course at a walk

Medical armbands to be worn on the cross country

Competitors to provide bibs, paper numbers will be available
Bibs will be available to hire if needed

CONDITIONS OF SHOW

1. Organisers reserve the right to refuse admission to the showground.
2. The organisers accept no responsibility for accidents, theft or loss whatsoever arising out of the show.
3. No entry will be accepted without the correct entry fee. No stables will be booked without correct payment or credit card details.
4. *Refund of entry fee.* Cancellation must be received prior to the closing date or if later supported by a doctors or veterinary certificate
5. Each Horse or Pony can only compete once in each class
6. Depending on the progress of the show, the organisers reserve the right to switch classes between rings.
7. No competitor shall allow a stallion for which he/she is responsible as owner, lessee, authorised agent or rider to compete or be prepared to compete, in any show jumping competition without taking adequate precautions to ensure other members of the public are not put at risk of injury.
8. All dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
9. Hats of the correct standard (PAS 015, ASTM F1163) or above must be worn at all times when mounted on the showground.
10. External Medical Cover is in attendance
11. Objections must be made in writing within 30 minutes of the end of the class, by the owner, his authorised agent or the rider, and logged with the secretary.
12. Schooling is not permitted in any of the rings.
