- THE ORGANISER RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REFUSE ENTRY, CANCEL OR ALTER CLASSES.
- CLASSES MAY BE LIMITED OR COMBINED AT THE ORGANISER'S DISCRETION.
- HATS TO THE CURRENT STANDARDS MUST BE WORN WHEN RIDING AT ALL TIMES.
