Competition:

Individuals will be awarded prizes to 6th place in each class. Classes open to all.
Teams may be made up of 3 or 4 competitors from **ANY** class. Prizes for the Best Team, Best Family Team, Best Veteran Team (over 50), Best Hunt Team, Best Riding Club Team, Best Pony Club Team (best 3 scores to count)
Series Combinations with the highest points accumulated during the series at the same height throughout the series will be awarded special prizes

Entry Fee: £25 for Class 1 and £30 for Classes 2-4

This competition is being run on BE Arena Eventing speeds. Eventers Challenge is a two phase competition, competitors will jump a course of show jumps immediately followed by cross country fences and will finish with the last fence as a show jump, the joker fence, 10cm higher than the rest of the course. Knocking down the joker fence will incur 6 faults.

Points League: Points will be awarded at each event in the series. At Aldon and Holbrook, 8 points will be awarded to those placed 1st, 7 points to 2nd etc. to 1 point for 8th place. Those unplaced incurring no jumping penalties will also be awarded 1 point. At the final at Melbury the points will be multiplied by a factor of 1.5. 12 points will be awarded to first place, 10.5 to 2nd place etc and 1.5 points to those with no jumping penalties. Points for the series will be accumulated at each height separately (but nothing to stop you competing in another height and gaining points at that height too).

RULES

- The classes are **OPEN TO ALL**
- Horses/ponies 4 years of age and above may compete in 70cm and 80cm classes
- Horses/ponies 5 years of age and above may compete in 90cm and 100 cm classes
- Stop watches are **not** permitted
- Clear rounds take precedence over anyone with jumping faults and the winner will be the one nearest to the optimum time. In the event of a tie the winner will be the one with clear round, closest to the optimum time and under the optimum time.
- Time allowed is twice the optimum time
- There will be a drawn order and approximate times will be given in advance of the day
- The course will only be open to walk, before the class starts
- The Judges` decision is final
- Back protectors must be worn of BETA 2009 or BETA 2018 standards.
- Hats must be of BE, PC or RC standards.

Hats and Body protectors will be checked at the Secretaries before competing.

Stabling will be available locally contact Sara Greenwood if needed.

Riders will need to supply number bibs. A few bibs will be available, £10 deposit.

Health and Safety:

The organisers of the event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these precautions to be effective everyone must obey the instructions of the organisers and officials at all times.

Summary of competition rules:

4 penalties for knocking down a show jump

4 penalties for a refusal or disobedience in the show jumping phase

10 penalties for knocking down a cross country fence

20 penalties for a refusal or disobedience in the cross country phase

6 penalties for knocking down the joker fence

Elimination for fall or horse and/or rider

Elimination for 3rd cumulative refusal or disobedience

0.4 penalties per second over the optimum time

0.4 penalties per second in excess of 5 seconds under the optimum time
