POINTS SERIES

Each class at each dressage competition will earn points towards our points series. The horse/rider combination with the highest points at the end of the year will win a Leather bridle and the runner up will receive a Leather Headcollar. Juniors (18 years and under) will have their own points series with any class being eligible, please indicate junior when entering. Points will be awarded from 1st to 6th place and will be 6 points for 1st, 5 points for 2nd and so on. So be sure to attend as many shows as possible over the year so you can keep collecting points.

This show is a qualifier for The Sunshine Tour Championships held at The All England Jumping Course, Hickstead from Thursday 17th – Sunday 20th September 2020.

The Championships are for unaffiliated and amateur competitors in Dressage from Intro to Elementary.

Qualification: 1st – 4th place. Qualification does not pass down the line.

Dressage Training Days

Would you like to try and improve your dressage score or have a chance to practice a dressage test under more informal conditions?

Our dressage training days are a chance for you to ride a test in front of the judge, then have 20 minutes to work on and discuss your test before re-riding your test.

These sessions are 30 minutes in total.

You will receive your before and after scored test sheets.

These are informal training days and so competition wear is not necessary. The tests for these days will be the tests running prior to the competition date. And you can book for either the Tuesday prior to competition day.

Rules

1. All classes will be judged under British Dressage rules.
2. Riding hats which comply with current BS safety standards must be worn at all times whilst mounted on the showground.
3. No horses are to be schooled or lunged in the car park or any other areas.
4. The designated ‘warm up’ arena is the only area to be used to ‘warm up’ horses/ponies. It is not permitted in the showground or car park for safety reasons.
5. Horses and /or ponies should never be left unattended, when tied to a lorry or trailer
6. Dogs must be kept on leads and under strict control at all times. Owners are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs.
7. The organiser reserves the right to unconditionally disqualify and/or ban riders who display an excessive use of whips and/or spurs or those who use bad language or behave in an unsporting manner.
8. Anyone who is seen to be riding in a manner likely to endanger themselves, their horse or other parties, will be asked to leave the showground for safety reasons.
9. No Horse/Pony may be entered more than once in any class.
10. Horses/Ponies must be over the age of 4 to compete in any classes.
11. The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry, make changes or cancel a class without stating a reason.
12. Complaints of any nature must be logged in writing with the secretary, together with a deposit of £15 within one hour of class finishing. If the objection is proved correct the £15 deposit will be refunded.
13. The Judges decision is always final.
14. All entries/competitors must have valid and adequate Horse and Rider Insurance including Third Party Liability Cover.
15. All entries/competitors and spectators must comply at all times with any Health & Safety notices/rules or instructions given by the organiser.
16. The organiser accepts no responsibility for any accidents or injury to competitors, onlookers, horses or property. Riding is a high risk sport and is undertaken at your own risk.

Competition reminders

- *Gloves must be worn*
- *Remove any brushing or over-reach BOOTS before you compete*
- *Do not use your voice during your test*
- *Do not salute with the whip in your hand!*
