- In the event of cancellation due to adverse weather conditions, entry fees will be returned less £2.50 for administration.
- . Competitors may withdraw from a class at any time but withdrawals after the closing date will not be refunded.

COVID RULES

Everyone involved in this event including staff, officials, volunteers and competitors should familiarize themselves with these procedures.

Track and Trace details must be submitted with entries for all people attending.

There will be no face-to-face contact with secretarial staff at the event, any enquires regarding entries or something similar must be directed to the appointed Covid Officer on the day of competition.

No entries will be accepted or amended during the event

It is essential that we all work together to follow the relevant guidance for a safe and successful event.

ENTRY TO THE SHOWGROUND

Anyone who has shown or has been in contact with someone showing any symptoms may not enter the showground.

Anyone who, in the opinion of the Covid officer, is showing symptoms of covid-19 will be required to leave the premises immediately.

Social distancing must be practiced at all times whilst on the showground. Anyone in breach of the social distancing guidelines will be asked to leave the showground immediately.

Riders may be accompanied by one person for each horse entered, to a maximum of three people, not including the rider

Only from the following categories of people may enter the showground during the event.

- Rider
- Groom
- · Horse Owner
- Parent/Guardian of rider (if under 16yrs of age) People who are not in any of the above categories will not be permitted entry to the showground.

This is a closed door event.

Absolutely no spectators will be permitted to enter the show ground or lorry park.

The wearing of facemasks is mandatory at all times in the showground for non-riders. Riders will be requested to wear facemasks when walking the track but not when riding.

Accompanied person may only watch the rider that they have come with inside from when the rider enters the collecting ring and must vacate the building as soon as they have finished that round. Facemasks must be worn at all times whilst indoors.

LORRY PARKING

Please do not arrive at the show ground earlier than 1 hour before the published start time of your first class.

Vehicles will be stopped at the entrance to the lorry park and personnel details, as listed on your entry form will be checked by the track and trace officer on duty.

WARM UP

There will be 2 warm up facilities for the showjumping (one flat and one jumping) and ${\bf 1}$ for dressage.

Competitors will be grouped in bubbles of five and will only progress into the warm up facilities as per steward instructions. Times will be allocated for warm up and competition. At no time will there be more than five riders in the warm up area.

There will be a allocated steward in the warm up that will adjust fences as required STRICTLY no one else may enter collecting ring.

Riders must not enter warm up area once their round is completed.

When riders have finished all classes entered, they must load up and leave the showground.
