- 1. Large M & M Breeds To be registered with the relevant society.
- 75 cms.
 - 2. Small M & M Breeds To be registered with the relevant society.
- 65cms.
- 3. Tots including Lead Rein 40cms Rider not to have attained their 10th birthday by 01/01/2024. If you enter this class, you cannot enter any other WH class on the same pony.
 - 4. Nursery Stakes 50cms Riders not to have attained their 13th birthday before 1st January of the current year.
 - 5. 55cms Worker Stakes Open to all ages of rider, any breed/height of horse or pony.
- 6. 65cms Worker Stakes Open to all ages of rider, any breed/height of horse or pony.
- 7. 75cms Worker Stakes Open to all ages of rider, any breed/height of horse or pony.
 - 8. 85cms Worker Stakes Open to all ages of rider, any breed/height of horse or pony.

 - 13. Ridden Coloured Open to horse/pony.
- (Plaited/Native/Traditional to be awarded points according to type)
- 14. Ridden Veteran Lead Rein allowed. Open to all breed types of
- horse/pony age 14 years and above.
- 15. Ridden Show Pony/Show Hunter Pony Show Pony to exceed
 128cms and not to exceed 148cms. Show Hunter Pony to exceed
 122cms and not to exceed 153cms. Cannot enter class 42 if
 entering this class.
- 16. Open Ridden Registered Small Breeds M & M Must be registered with the relevant breed society.
- 17. Open Ridden Registered Large Breeds M & M Must be registered with the relevant breed society.
- 18. Riding Club Horse / Riding Club Pony Riders any age, may include a small jump/obstacle.

RING 3 – IN HAND SHOWING RING. Start Time 9:30am

- 19. Youngstock Open to foals and youngstock 3 years and under.
- Any breed/type. Filly, colt, or gelding. Colts to be handled by a competent person aged 16 years or over.
- 20. In-Hand Solid Traditional Open to horse/pony. Cannot enter class 26 if entering this class.
- 21. In-Hand Show Horse (Hack/Riding Horse/ROR) Show horses to exceed 148cms. To be shown plaited and trimmed.
 - 22. In-Hand Show Pony & Show Hunter Pony To be shown plaited
- and trimmed. Show Pony to exceed 128cms and not to exceed 148cms. Show Hunter Pony to exceed 122cms and not to exceed 153cms.
- 23. In-Hand Registered M & M Large Breeds Must be registered with the relevant breed society.
- 24. In-Hand Show Hunter/Show Cob Hunters to exceed 148cms to be shown plaited and trimmed. Show Cobs to be shown hogged and trimmed.
- 25. In-Hand Veteran Open to all breed types of horse/ponies, age 14 years and above.
- 26. In-Hand Coloured Open to horse/pony. Plaited/Native/Traditional to be awarded points according to type)
 - 27. Senior Handler Handlers to be 18 years and over on the 1^{st} January of the current year.
 - 28. In-Hand Registered M & M Small Breeds (excluding Shetland) –
- Must be registered with the relevant breed society.
 - 29. In-Hand Unregistered Horse/Pony to include Part Bred Arab & Part Bred M & M Breeds.

- 30. Junior Handler Handlers to be 12 years & over on the 1st January of the current year.
 - 31. In-Hand Best Condition Open to any breed/Type/Age/Horse/Pony.
- 32. In-Hand Shetland Must be registered with the relevant breed society.

RING 4 – EQUITATION & JUNIOR RING. Start Time 9:00am

- 33. Best Turned Out To be shown mounted or unmounted, any breed/type of horse/pony. Any age rider/handler.
- 34. Senior Equitation Riders to have attained 18th birthday by 1st January of the current year. Snaffle bridles only.
- 35. Junior Equitation Riders not to have attained 18th birthday before 1st January of the current year. Snaffle bridles only.
- 36. First Ridden Equitation Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January of the current year. Snaffle bridles only.
- 37. Lead Rein Equitation Riders not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Snaffle bridles only. Lead rein to be attached to the noseband.
 - 38. Starter Ridden Equitation For genuine novice/nervous riders of any age. You cannot enter any other equitation class if entering this class and only eligible for one season only.
 - 39. Unregistered Horse/Pony to include Part Bred Arab & Part Bred Native Breeds To include lead rein. Riders any age.
 - 40. Novelty Theme to be announced prior to each show date.
- 41. Lead Rein M & M Show Pony & Show Hunter Pony. Rider not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st January of the current year. Snaffle bridle only. Lead rein to be attached to the noseband. You cannot enter class 15 if entering this class.
- 42. First Ridden M & M − Show Pony and Show Hunter Pony. Rider not to have attained 12th birthday before 1st January of the current year. Cannot enter class 16 if entering this class.
- 43. Young Handler Handler not to have attained their 12th birthday by 1st January of the current year.
