

BRADBOURNE RDA KNOLE RIDE: IMPORTANT INFORMATION

The team at Bradbourne RDA are looking forward to welcoming you to the Knole Ride.

START & FINISH POINTS

Parking for the ride and the start and finish points will be at Redlands, by kind permission of Sevenoaks Riding Club. Please note the rustic and show jumps are strictly out of bounds at Redlands.

There is no postcode for Redlands itself but Fawke Wood Road is nearest, TN15 0SP. For anyone using What3Words the location is *Dream, Groom, Turkey*.



From Sevenoaks: Take the A225, turn left into St Julians Road and Redlands is approx. 1 mile on the right. From A21: At North Tonbridge exit take A225 for Sevenoaks. At the top of a very steep hill turn sharp angled right into St Julians Road. Redlands is approx. 1 mile on the right. We will use RDA signs on the day to direct you from the main road.

ON THE DAY

The Hutch Deli will be attending to provide post (or pre) bacon sandwiches, tea, coffee and other snacks. We will be running a second-hand tack stall, with items for both the horse and rider, so remember to bring some extra cash, you never know what you might find!

There will be no published start times, you can start at any time during the 30 mins you have entered (or hour in the last class.) Please don't worry if you're late, we all appreciate it can be stressful travelling to an event. Please arrive 30 minutes ahead of your time and ensure you check in with the secretary and collect your bib. Please return the bib at the end of the ride and collect your rosette.

RIDE ROUTE

There will be a photographer from LRG photography on the route, to capture your ride through this beautiful deer park.

The ride is a circular route of approx. 10km through the park including an opportunity to ride on the historic gallops (galloping is optional!) The gallops can be ridden twice. There are no jumps on this route and there will be stewards throughout the route. To gain access to the park there is a road crossing point, which will be stewarded to assist with horses crossing.

We are able to run this ride with permissions from the Knole Estate and the Sackville family. This is a deer park and the animals are only enclosed by the perimeter fence of the park and have free roam throughout. Please do not jump natural obstacles not on the ride route.
