

WORC Jigsaw 3 Day Event

“All pieces fit together for a final result”

- *Have you ever wanted to compete in a One Day Event but you couldn't cope with all 3 phases in one day, or your horse wouldn't? – this is for you!*
- *Have you struggled with wanting to do ride a novice level test but only jump 50cm – this is for you!*
- *Did you want to jump higher but your dressage canter has more jump then dressage? – this is for you!*

WORC are excited to announce the inaugural WORC Jigsaw 3 Days Event

We are running 3 days of competition throughout November and December. These are open to members and non members of WORC – treat them like a normal day competition, however.....

Our **NEW WORC Jigsaw Event** allows you to enter each competition AND a Jigsaw Class which takes into account your results from the Jigsaw dressage, Jigsaw showjumping AND Jigsaw Arena XC to give you a final result so a 4th opportunity to win **prizes, sashes and rosettes**.

You choose your test and your jumping height at time of entry

When: 3rd November 2024 – Showjumping (Outdoor on surface)
17th November 2024 – Dressage (Indoors)
1st December 2024 – Arena XC (Outdoor on surface)

Warning Lower Haddon Livery is situated next to Brize Norton RAF Base so there may be low flying aircrafts during the day.

Event Rules: Dressage, Showjumping & Arena XC rules are standard BRC competition rules

Jigsaw Rules: You must enter an appropriate dressage test and height - checks will be made!

If you are currently riding at Novice, please do not enter the Intro test etc

If you are riding at both Prelim and Novice, you may enter both classes etc

If you are jumping 80cm don't jump 50cm etc

You can enter ANY height for Showjumping and Arena XC **BUT** you must jump the same height in Showjumping and Arena XC for the Jigsaw

By entering the jigsaw class you are declaring which height and test you are doing at entry stage

You may enter the Jigsaw event twice at different test and height levels on one horse.

You may enter one or more heights and tests as part of the open competitions

The committee reserve the right to cancel, amend or alter the order of these events

Results: Scores for the Jigsaw Event will be run as per eventing i.e. all 3 events combined for your total score

Results for each Open Class will be given out after each class

Results for the Jigsaw Competition will be announced after the Arena XC competition has finished and the results verified.

HEALTH AND SAFETY

The organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the official stewards. RULES & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Events and competitions are unaffiliated unless stated otherwise. However, they will be run in accordance with the BRC Handbook books and in addition the rules set out below.
2. The organisers and landowners accept no responsibility for any loss or damage to any person, animal, vehicle or property whatsoever – however caused. Owners/riders enter entirely at their own risk and it is a condition of entry that no liability of any kind attaches itself to the organisers, judges or landowner of the show in any respect whatsoever.
3. Correct riding attire must be worn – it is the rider's responsibility to ensure this rule is observed.
4. Correctly fitting headgear and boots with heels must be worn by anyone mounted on the showground. Headgear must conform to the current BHS safety standards and must be either standard or be prefixed with AST or SEI and must have a three point harness. Spot checks may be carried out. Non compliance will result in elimination. This rule takes precedent over rules on headgear/footwear contained in any Rules of Affiliated bodies.
5. Back protectors are recommended for show jumping and compulsory for Arena XC.
6. The judge's and/or organiser's decision is final
7. The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry without giving a reason and will return the entry fee accompanying such entry.
8. The judges reserve the right to eliminate any unfit or unsound horse/pony. Any person, in the opinion of an event official, seen ill treating a horse/pony will be required to leave the showground immediately and partake in no further competitions at that event regardless of any entry fee being paid.
9. Entry fees will only be refunded on the production of a medical or veterinary certificate.
10. Horse/Ponies are not to be left unattended when tied up to trailers or lorries in the car park.
11. Children must be properly supervised at all times.
12. Please do not leave any rubbish, droppings etc. on the showground.
13. Dogs are permitted on the showground, but must be kept on a lead. Please clean up after them.
