Class 3: Preliminary 5 (2024) **Long Arena**

Open to all.

Class 4: Novice 3 (2024)

Open to all.

Class 5: Novice 4 (2024) **Long Arena**

Open to all.

Class 6: Elementary 2 (2024)

Open to all.

By entering this competition, competitors accept the risks involved in horse riding and competing. Save for death or injury caused by the negligence of the landowner or officials of Witheridge Riding Club for which they are legally responsible, the landowners and officials will not accept any liability for any accident, loss, injury or damage to competitors, attendants, property, vehicles, animals, or spectators of any description.

The organisers will take reasonable precautions to safeguard the health and safety of everyone present. For these to be effective, competitors and spectators are required to take due care at all times and to obey any notices or requests made by official stewards in the interests of their own and others safety.

Hats, to current British Riding Club rules, must be worn and securely fastened when mounted.

The judge's decision is final.

Objections must be made to the Secretary's Office within 10 minutes of the results, or incident, with a £10 deposit. The deposit will be reimbursed if the objection is upheld.

Dogs MUST be kept on a lead at all time, and under control.

Please keep the car parking area tidy, picking up droppings, hay etc (and take it home with you!!).

In the case of adverse weather, and the need to abandon the competition, this will be published on the website www.witheridgerc.org (linking to Equo) and the Witheridge Riding Club Facebook page. In this case, there will be a full refund less expenses.
